

The Jane Stickle Quilt - Block I1




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
What you need:

Patches	Quantity/size
A*	(2) 1" x 6"
B*	(2) 1" x 5"
С	(10) 1¼" x 1¼" - light blue (8) 1¼" x 1¼" - navy
D	(2) 2 ³ /4" x 2 ³ /4"

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is ¾". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly 5½".





Assembly:

- 1. Sew two light blue Unit C to opposite sides of navy Unit C. Make four.
- 2. Sew two navy Unit C to opposite sides of light blue Unit C. Make two.
- 3. Arrange and sew Step 1 and Step 2 rows together.
- 4. Arrange Step 3 blocks with Unit D as shown and sew together.
- 5. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
- 6. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.





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
