## Block L13

## What you need:

| Patches | Quantity/size |
| :--- | :--- |
| A* $^{*}$ | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ |
| B* $^{*}$ | (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| C | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ - cut twice diagonally - light blue |
| D | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ - cut twice diagonally - navy |
| E | (1) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ - cut twice diagonally - green |

*The actual required width for Unit A and Unit B units is $3 / 4$ ". The increased width specified above allows for squaring the block to exactly $512^{\prime \prime}$.

## Assembly:

1. Assemble and sew together two Unit D and two Unit E to make one quarter-square triangle (OST) block. Repeat to make a second block.
2. Using Unit D circle template on Page L13-2, cut circle from one Step 1 OST block.
3. Assemble and sew together four Unit C to make a one OST block.
4. Appliqué Step 2 circle to Step 3 OST block, matching seams.
5. Using Unit E circle template on Page L13-s, cut circle from second Step 1 OST block.
6. Appliqué Step 5 circle to Step 4 QST block, matching seams and color pattern. Square block to $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$.
7. Join Unit B to the right side of the block, and then the left.
8. Join Unit A to the top of the block and then the bottom. Square up block to measure $5^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51^{1 / 2}$ square.


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
